

Carriage for Forklift

Carriages and Carriage Parts - There are 4 sizes of hook type fork carriages rated by the blade carriage hoisting capability. Hook type blade carriages have been the same.

Class I carriages are rated for loads as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted tines vary by the amount of offset between the tine and the fork eye. Some makers will vary the carriages for pin type blades. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
