Utility Bucket - Universal Fit buckets likewise go by the name "slip-on-the-forks" lift truck accessory buckets. Typical universal lift truck buckets attach to forks that are up to six inches wide and are forty eight inches long. Larger fork pockets can be ordered through an account manager upon request.

Since universal fit lift truck buckets slip onto the blades directly, they stay on the machine and are a lot less vulnerable to destruction. These buckets are also 50% deeper as opposed to the quick-tach bucket models. This extra room makes them perfect for lifting irregular shaped loads like for instance elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls and tearing off roof trash.

Quick-Tach Buckets

Quick-Tach Buckets are made for extendable-reach lift trucks. They are designed to allow positioning of material far beyond the reach of a loader. A hardened beveled cutting blade on both sides and on the leading edge reinforces strength, resistance to damage and offers supreme durability. Quick-Tach lift truck buckets are reinforced by scuff bars along the bottom of the unit that shield it from scrapes.

Quick-Tach forklift buckets can be used to swap the carriage and forks which weigh between 100-700lbs. When set up, these buckets free up more of the unit's cargo capacity, enabling it to handle heavier and larger stuff. The Quick-Tach is able to pour materials more or less 1.5 feet higher due to the shorter depth of its bucket. These buckets are fabricated in a customized fashion in order to suit the specifications of particular models and makes of lift trucks.
