The 4 Main Types of Floor Scrubber

These automatic models could be programmed to work without an operator.

1. Fold-away Floor Scrubbers

Fold-away floor scrubbers are perfect in small businesses where space is limited. Vacuums and floor cleaning equipment must be packed away effectively in storage places and small cupboards. This is when the folding machine style comes in useful. With this particular type of floor scrubber, the main arm that is used so as to maneuver the machine could be folded in several places, making the machinery compact whenever it is not being utilized.

2. Mains & Battery Operated

Even if Mains operated floor scrubbers are the most popular, the battery operated model is well suited for locations where the available utility sockets are some distance away from the floor that needs scrubbing and extended power leads are not an option. The battery operated model is best suited for small places like washrooms with hard to reach places which will be hard to clean with a trailing power lead. The battery could be charged and used for approximately 4 hours previous to re-charging is needed. The battery can likewise be replaced if necessary.

3. Ride-on or Walking machines

Another great option for a floor scrubber if the area you need it for is big like warehouses and various industrial locations are the walking or ride-on scrubber machinery. These machines will allow the operator to maneuver the equipment all-around corners and obstructions efficiently and easily. These types of floor scrubbing equipment come equipped with a 250L water tank and one more tank to collect the filthy water. Walking machines are similar models which could be operated by someone walking behind the machinery and maneuvering the scrubber.

4. Robotic Floor Scrubber devices

A robotic floor scrubber could be another alternative to think about. These designs are ideal if you need a high specification floor scrubber to clean a big environment which has minimal obstacles. These versions have sensors installed so as to allow the machine the ability to steer clear of humans, doors, walls and stairs. It could finish the cleaning job with no trouble as soon as you start the unit up and set the course, it will clean all by itself. These floor scrubbers are capable of cleaning a thousand square feet with each 4 hour charge.
